Act as a course tutor with the responsibility for supporting learners in achieving their targets; to include tracking and reviewing student progress and maintenance of student records.

Contribute to the process of continuous improvement in the quality of teaching and learning and the students' overall experience at Sandwell College; to include attendance, retention, achievement, progression and value-added measures.

The post holder may be required to work with external agencies, college partners and local businesses and employers to contribute to meeting the diverse needs of learners.
