#### OVERVIEW

Wigan & Leigh College was established in 1857 and is the only general further education college in the metropolitan borough of Wigan. Wigan Borough is part of Greater Manchester (GM) and with a population of 317k is the second most populous borough in GM. The borough is in the northwest of GM and borders Merseyside, Lancashire and Cheshire.

The college operates from a number of sites across the borough. Parsons Walk Centre, School for the Arts, The Centre for Advanced Technical Studies and the Pagefield Centre are located in Wigan, near to the town centre. Leigh College and Leigh Adult Learning Centre are located in the town of Leigh.

The college is a general further education college offering curriculum activity across all core qualification types:

The curriculum is focused on vocational / technical education with a small A Level offer. The largest curriculum departments are Engineering, Construction, and Health & Social Care. Specialisms are focused around four Centres of Excellence in Engineering, Health & Social Care, Sport, and Creative Arts, along with our newly launched Digital Academy.

The college is rated as Ofsted Grade 2, has outstanding financial health and has self-assessed as Grade 2 for the 20/21 academic year. Income for 20/21 was £34.5M and is projected to be £34.5M for 21/22.











## 16-18 STUDY PROGRAMMES















There are currently 3,198 students taking study programmes at Wigan & Leigh College. The curriculum offer is from Entry Level to Level 3 with the majority of activity at Level 3 (55%). Advanced level study incorporates vocational and A Level study. T Levels were launched in Sept 2021 and they have attracted more than 100 enrolments.

Our dedicated Head of Studies teams, based at each campus, lead and oversee all tutorial and pastoral care and are in addition to academic personal tutors. The Head of Studies teams lead on safeguarding, enhancement and learner voice, as well as being a key part of the college's attendance and retention strategies.

Careers, work placement and destination planning is led by the FAB Futures team. Based on each campus, they work with Head of Studies and Curriculum Heads to deliver a fully embedded careers entitlement.

Student satisfaction rates are high. The latest data from FE Choices saw Wigan & Leigh College in the top 8% nationally and highest in Greater Manchester.

HIGHER EDUCATION





The college has recently made a multi-million pound investment across its centres to provide top of the range facilities, resources and learning environments. The college has also been selected as one of 16 providers to receive capital funding, as part of the Department for Education's Transformation Fund, for a substantial rebuild of the Parsons Walk Centre.
