2	Deliver and facilitate assessment and training in light vehicle mechanics that encourages accelerated learning and results in new knowledge and skills.	
3	Use information Technology (ILT) in the development of learning materials and use multimedia learning resources in the delivery of the learning experience.	
4	Deliver programmes in line with the college prospectus.	
5	Participate in the development of the curriculum.	



6	Monitor and review learner issues on a regular basis, taking any necessary action to limit the number of early leavers.			
7	Manage and complete both business and personal administration within given timescales i.e. delegate satisfaction surveys, reviews and reports etc.			
8	Ensure knowledge of all subject areas including technical training and continued professional development (CPD) is kept constantly updated.			
9	Work as part of the automotive team and give feedback, offer ideas and suggestions for improving team performance.			
10	Understand where the role fits within the programme team and work closely with colleagues on specific projects.			
11	Maintain records for both academic and administrative purposes.			
12	Take responsibility for courses and tutorship.			
13	Have and agreed teaching load.			
14	Use your knowledge to teach to the highest standards at all times.			
15	Carry out any other duties in accordance with the procedures specified in the college policies.
