Job Title: Lecturer - Plumbing

## **Overall Responsibilities:**

 To prepare, deliver, assess and verify plumbing and heating on a range of courses and levels.

- To contribute pro-actively in the development of the Centre curriculum incorporating innovative teaching strategies.
- To support and guide students to achieve success and realise their potential.
- Manage students learning and provide a high quality learning experience.

#### Main Duties:

- 1. To teach effectively on a range of plumbing programmes, levels and qualifications, recognising and meeting student's individual needs.
- 2. To prepare schemes of work which are current and fully meet the awarding body requirements and criteria
- 3. To extend the students learning experience through developing and implementing appropriate vocational opportunities e.g. work experience and links with employers
- 4. Contribute effectively to curriculum development incorporating any alterations required due to awarding body or funding changes.
- 5. To update via cpd developments in subject specialism and course amendments and share expertise with plumbing colleagues.
- 6. Develop research and implement new learning materials so as to engage students in learning.
- 7. Undertake a range of theoretical and practical lessons to a variety of full and part time students on different plumbing qualification and varying levels.
- 8. Assess student's work effectively meeting awarding body standards and comply with internal verification and moderation.

- 9. Ensure all students behaviour is in line with Bedford College student code of conduct within and outside teaching areas.
- 10. Record and monitor students' progress, ensuring they meet the required standards and expected deadlines.
- 11. Update student's e-personal learning plan, highlighting any concerns or issues which may impact on their overall success, in conjunction with Course Managers and Personal Tutors.
- 12. Ensure learning environments are interesting and the learning experience includes diversity awareness and conforms to all Health and Safety requirements.
- 13. Participate in and contribute effectively at staff, and course meetings.
- 14. Interview potential students ensuring the meet the entry criteria and carry out internal assessments.
- 15. Complete accurately and to any required deadlines a range of administrative tasks relating to students and courses, to include enrolments, registers transfers and withdrawals meeting all funding requirements.
- 16. To be aware of and implement the statutory requirements for promoting and safeguarding the welfare of children and young people in the College.
- 17. Carry out effectively any other associated duties as requested by the Assistant Director.
