The facilities for the Fashion & Textiles provision currently consist of a specialist Fashion & Textiles Studio complete with a large cutting table, Hoffman industrial press, bank of domestic Janome sewing machines, mannequins, wet area for textile experiments and storage for individual storage for student work.

In 2019 we opened our brand new contemporary theatre with state of the art technology providing students within the Centre of Excellence for Performing Arts a cutting edge performance space. The theatre will have a diverse and accommodating stage area with an orchestra pit allowing for more sizeable and challenging productions and is utilised for our annual end of year fashion show.
