Job Purpose:

To assist teaching staff in the day-to-day operation of the construction facilities. To ensure all equipment is in good working order by either providing maintenance or organising suitable repairs. Maintain workshops, assessment bays and hygiene facilities. Identifying and ordering materials. Carrying out risk assessments and COSHH assessments. Stock taking and managing suppliers. Providing first aid cover.

Key Responsibilities:

To provide assistance to teaching staff in the construction section by:

- 1. Preparing resources and workshops for teaching staff
- 2. Undertaking regular checking and routine maintenance on equipment to ensure that it is in safe working order
- 3. Arranging the annual maintenance of electrical equipment.
- 4. Carrying out an annual stock check of items of equipment of £500 + value.
- 5. Maintaining stock records.
- 6. Distribution and reclamation of materials.
- 7. To issue students lockers and keep suitable records.
- 8. Ordering materials, checking delivery notes and invoices.
- 9. To keep management fully and regularly informed of issues affecting the operation of the construction resources
- 10. Showing a positive and responsible attitude towards safety and hygiene within the College, by maintaining a clean and tidy working environment.
- 11. Undertake a First Aid qualification and administer first aid if necessary.
- 12. Undertake such other duties commensurate with the grade of the post as may reasonably be required.
- 13. Carry out appropriate health and safety checks, risk assessments and COSHH assessments
