Purpose Statement:

We are looking for a Professional Trainer in the Area Health and Social Care, and Science to join the existing team to provide quality teaching and learning for students, preparing appropriate delivery material and carrying out teaching to the requirements of individual courses and students. The focus of the post will be in healthcare science, working with learners in a laboratory environment developing essential skills to prepare them for work in the science industry, and also to prepare learners for work placement. The postholder will work with external stakeholders including ESNEFT to develop work placement opportunities and ensure learners are best equipped to progress to employment or higher education in science.

Main Duties & Responsibilities:			
1	Teaching responsibilities; preparation, delivery, individual student tutoring and marking.		
2	To contribute to the development of learner laboratory skills in preparation for learners to attend work placement.		
3	To maintain appropriate student attendance records as required.		
4	To monitor learner progress including carrying out regular progress reviews and target setting.		
5	To keep and maintain accurate records and documentation.		
6	To organise and monitor learner science-based work placements, including visits and associated administration.		
7	To develop, maintain and extend links with a range of external organisations, including ESNEFT, as appropriate, developing links to support student progression and to inform curriculum planning.		
8	To attend, as required, up to 6 meetings a year as specified by the Head of Area. They may include course review meetings and curriculum development meetings.		
9	To complete appropriate awarding body documentation and ensure compliance of required procedures.		
10	Adhere to and promote the College's Safeguarding, Equality & Diversity, College Values and Health and Safety policies and practices.		



11	To develop and update personal professional expertise in the relevant areas.
12	Adhere to and promote the College's Safeguarding, Diversity, Equity & Inclusion, College Values and Health and Safety policies and practices.
13	To undertake any other associated duties determined by the college.
