## **Role Specific**

- 1. Teach on Level 3 T level and BTEC courses, delivering effective and high quality learning to student
- 2. Engage in recruitment activities with local schools and students
- 3. Engage with local employers to generate work placement opportunities for learners
- 4. Plan and prepare outstanding quality teaching and learning materials
- 5. Develop and share resources for the course/subject within the team
- 6. Take charge of own personal development and up skilling as required
- 7. Deliver enrichment and enhancement activities
- 8. Undertake required assessment duties in relation to student assignments.
- 9. Maintain comprehensive, up to date, student/course/subject records and provide information as requested
- 10. Be responsible for the appropriate administration of exam entries for the course/subject and liaise with external awarding bodies as appropriate.
- 11. Ensure close liaison and good communications with other staff in matters concerning students
- 12. Use college systems to track and communicate student progress
- 13. Tutor experience be able to provide relevant support and guidance to learners.
- 14. Have some knowledge of VR and how this can be implemented into curriculum.
- 15. Effectively manage the behaviour of students
- 16. Engage in curriculum development and planning activities, individually and as a team
- 17. Participate in standardisation/verification and moderation, as required
- 18. Ensure provision is aligned with best practice nationally
- 19. Take responsibility as required for the development of a relevant curriculum area
- 20. Take responsibility for achieving the section's targets in retention, attendance, achievements, high grades, added value and student satisfaction
