



Job Description: Art Technician

Role Specific

- 1. To prepare classes for practical activities and to ensure Art materials are available for learners to use.
- 2. To take delivery of art material/ supplies and stack/store correctly.
- 3. Provision of a store service and art materials and equipment booking system
- 4. Maintain stock records.
- 5. Provision of technical advice and assistance to staff and students engaged on practical or assignment work.
- 6. To provide support across other workshops and teams within the Creative Division during department specific/ College projects.
- 7. To ensure satisfactory standards of safety and security are maintained and work to health & safety requirements, attending training seminars as required.
- 8. Keeping work areas organised and tidy, ensuring safe and easy access to Art equipment and materials.
- 9. Transporting equipment/materials as necessary to and from sites, venues and classrooms.
- 10. Undertake any other duties that may be reasonably required, commensurate with the grade and scope of this post and agreed with the relevant line manager. This may include supporting College events which may be outside normal hours of work.
