

Job Description: Construction & The Built Environment Lecturer

Role Specific

1. Lead on the development of the T level curriculum plan in design, surveying and planning for construction
 2. Develop an employer network to support delivery of T Level work experience placements in design, surveying and planning for construction.
 3. Identify key resources for the successful delivery of the T Level programme and procure with support of other college departments.
 4. Teach on a range of elements across the College's FE mainly but not exclusively the T level and tutorials within your vocational trade area.
 5. Contribute to the delivery of our University Centre offer for HNC/D Sustainable Construction and Sustainable Technologies.
 6. Be up to date, plan and prepare and high-quality teaching as required by your Line Manager to the appropriate number of hours (810 hrs per annum FT this will be reduced in year 1 for curriculum development duties)
 7. Develop and share resources for the course/subject including maintaining effective links across College for resources
 8. Deliver enrichment and enhancement activities as required
 9. Maintain comprehensive, up to date, student/course/subject records and provide information, as requested
 10. Be responsible for the appropriate administration of exam entries for the course/subject and liaise with external awarding bodies, as appropriate
 11. Ensure close liaison and good communications with other staff in matters concerning students and curriculum development
 12. Use College systems to track and communicate student progress
 13. Flexibility to work evenings within contractual arrangements
 14. Act as a Personal Tutor, if required
 15. Value and support students to achieve their full potential
 16. Effectively manage the behaviour of students
 17. Engage in curriculum development and planning activities, individually and as a team
 18. Participate in standardisation/verification and moderation, as required
 19. Ensure provision is aligned with best practice nationally
 20. Take responsibility as required for the development of a relevant curriculum area
 21. Take responsibility for achieving the section's targets in retention, attendance, achievements, high grades, added value and student satisfaction
